Ash Wednesday, February 17th - Day of Fast and Abstinence

- **Mass Times:** 7:30AM, 11AM (with school children), 5PM and 7PM at St. Mary Magdalen.

Fast and Abstinence Obligations: *Ash Wednesday and Good Friday are obligatory days of fasting and abstaining from meat. In addition, Fridays during Lent are obligatory days of abstaining from meat. Those aged 18 to 59 must observe the fast, which allows one full meal and two smaller meals that, added together, would not equal a full meal. Those aged 14 and up are to abstain from meat on all Fridays in Lent. For medical or other serious reasons, these obligations may be waived.*
